



### RAINY RIVER DISTRICT STEWARDSHIP BURSARY

Rainy River District Stewardship (RRDS) is a group of people residing in the Rainy River District with a broad spectrum of knowledge, skills and interests who are dedicated to advancing the responsible care of nature in the Rainy River District, for benefits now and in the future.

Two bursary awards are funded equally by RRDS and West Fraser.

Graduating Secondary School students who are residents of the Rainy River District, and who will be undertaking post-secondary studies, are eligible to apply for the RRDS Award. Preference will be given to students pursuing education in **environmental, agricultural, or natural resource management** related fields. The two winning recipients will receive \$750.00 each after successful completion of the first semester of post-secondary education (80% of courses passed).

To apply, submit a 400 to 600-word essay, typewritten, neatly handwritten, or printed, which will:

- Demonstrate your knowledge of a local or global environmental issue.
- Outline your involvement in any projects, activities and personal choices that have helped to make improvements to the environment.
- Describe how you envision your post-secondary activities will help to create a more sustainable future.
- Finally, describe how you envision any additional aspects of your personality and experience that you feel qualifies you for the RRDS Bursary.
